### **GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION:**

By submitting an abstract, you agree to the following:

- a. The abstract is scientifically sound and ethically approved.
- b. The abstract is not an advertisement, nor contains anything obscene, defamatory, libellous, unlawful or in any way actionable.
- c. All authors have seen and approved the abstract as submitted.
- d. If successful, all presenting authors must register as delegates, without exception, to attend the HCC-UK Annual Conference to present the research.

### **Please read the following requirements carefully before submitting your abstract:**

- Entries should be submitted in one of the following categories: Basic Science or Clinical Research. The format is simply free text with a maximum of 300 words in the abstract body. This does not include the title which can be up to 75 words.
- The 'Full title' should be presented sentence case (not in title case or block capitals), i.e. only the first letter of the title or appropriate terms such as abbreviations or proper nouns should be upper case.
- One table or figure can be included in your abstract - Any table or chart will count for 150 words out of your total.
- A maximum of 5 references can be included and should be submitted as a separate attachment.
- It is best to type your abstract straight into the online submission form, or alternatively paste the text from a word-processed document. Please use the symbol font for special characters. You can use the buttons to add formatting.

- Please do not include author details in the body of the abstract or in the abstract title. You will be asked to provide author details within the submission process. By default, you will be set as the 1st Author, but you can change this on the authors page, and add as many additional authors as you like in the order in which you would like them to appear.

Once you click the 'submit' button, the online submission page will change to a submission confirmation page and you will immediately receive a confirmation email and login details. If you do not receive this, please email [hcc-uk@execbs.com](mailto:hcc-uk@execbs.com).

Selected members of the HCC-UK Committee will review your abstract and you will be notified by **w/c Monday 16th February 2026** if your abstract has been accepted for presentation.

Abstract selection will be the responsibility of the HCC-UK Committee and their decision is final.

Instructions on the timings and duration of oral presentations and the format of posters will be given in subsequent correspondence which will be issued following review by the HCC-UK Committee. If an abstract cannot be presented at the Meeting, the secretariat must be notified in writing ahead of the Meeting to avoid compromise to the professionalism of the meeting.
